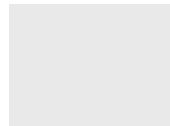

ACADEMIC TUTORING, EDUCATIONAL EVALUATION & GUIDANCE

ACADEMIC TUTORING: Our expert educators provide individual tutoring services tailored to the needs of each student. Academic year tutoring can directly support the student in his or her school curriculum or can provide a separate program of enrichment or remedial work. A combination of these approaches is often appropriate. While every case is different, most often our emphasis is on directly helping a student meet academic demands while teaching strategies and skills that the student can use in other situations as well. Summer tutoring offers a wide variety of scheduling and programming and the opportunity to help students prepare for the coming year, improve skills in challenge areas, or complete summer assignments.

QWERTY's staff consists of educators with varied backgrounds and distinct teaching strengths. Tutors meet individually with students in our offices, typically for one-hour sessions on a regularly scheduled basis during the school year. We provide brief, written reports on each tutoring session.

EDUCATIONAL EVALUATION and GUIDANCE: When parents and students are seeking more information about learning abilities, we can help. Each evaluation is tailored to the individual. Evaluation can be limited in scope to provide a basic measure of achievement and/or aptitude, or it can take the form of on-going, in-depth diagnostic testing combined with instruction. Our evaluation will include a review of other existing data followed by formal and informal assessments, written report production, and conferencing as needed. Such educational testing may be used to document a student's eligibility for special education services and classroom accommodations.

Parents and teachers also often seek our guidance on homework management, interpretation of existing evaluations, developing and implementing strategies for classroom support, reviewing class placement, and other questions related to creating greater academic success for students.
